The First Nations Research and Evaluation Fellow is a pathway for First Nations' academics to explore, design and deliver evaluation and research projects that are driven and led by First Nations' people and communities.

Community First Development launched the inaugural Fellowship in 2020. As part of the Fellowship Murran/ Iwaidja woman, Donna Stephens, our first Fellow, took a lead role in a participatory action research project with 11 communities across Australia. The final report has been published and findings presented at numerous events.
